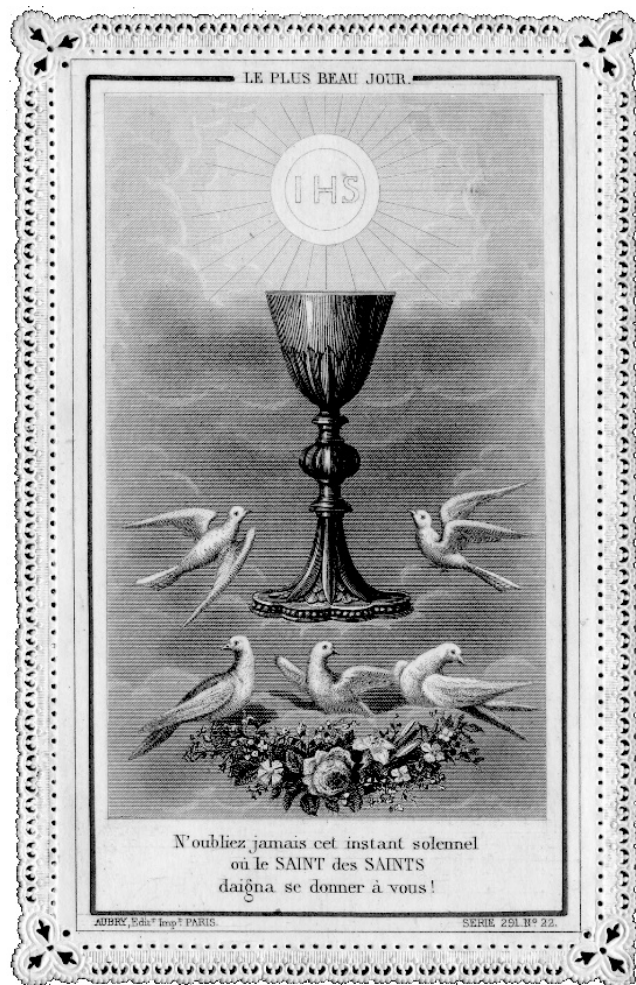

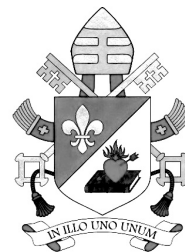

Today's Readings

Epistle (St. James 1. 17-21)

Bearly beloved, Every best gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no change nor shadow of alteration. For of His own will hath He begotten us by the word of truth, that we might be some beginning of His creature. You know, my dearest brethren. And let every man be swift to hear, but slow to speak and slow to anger. For the anger of man worketh not the justice of God. Wherefore, casting away all uncleanness and abundance of malice, with meekness receive the ingrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

Gospel (St. John 16. 5-14)

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: I go to Him that sent Me, and none of you asketh Me: Whither goest Thou? But because I have spoken these things to you, sorrow hath filled your heart. But I tell you the truth: it is expedient to you that I go: for if I go not, the Paraclete will not come to you: but if I go, I will send Him to you. And when He is come, He will convince the world of sin, and of justice and of judgment. Of sin, because they believed not in Me: and of justice, because I go to the Father, and you shall see Me no longer: and of judgment, because the prince of this world is already judged. I have yet many things to say to you: but you cannot bear them now. But when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will teach you all truth. For He shall not speak of Himself: but what things soever He shall hear, He shall speak, and the things that are to come, He shall show you. He shall glorify Me: because He shall receive of Mine and shall show it to you.

Capilla del Santo Cristo

In the year 1754, the people of San Juan, Puerto Rico celebrated the feast of St John the Baptist with a horse race through the streets of the city. As the contestants rounded a corner, the horse carrying one rider, Baltazar Montanez, lost its footing and both horse and rider plunged over the cliff on which the old city was built. The horse was killed, but, amazingly, Montanez was unharmed. The people of San Juan regarded this as a miracle, and a small chapel was build on the site (in the middle of the street!) to commemorate the event. The Capilla del Santo Cristo de la Salud remains one of the city's most beloved landmarks, and the faithful still come there to pray for help and Divine protection.
